
Visit to Taj Mahal, one of the seven wonders of the world

26 Sept 2019 (Thursday) Delhi / Agra - Surface (203 km / 4 hrs.) (L & D)

Today morning at **0730 hrs.** you will be picked-up from your hotel and driven to Agra. Upon arrival check-in at the hotel.

Agra Fort & Taj Mahal Tour with Sunset

In the afternoon, explore the 16th century **Agra Fort** with its battlements, apartments, gardens and audience halls. After that enjoy an extended visit to the magnificent **Taj Mahal**. Built by Shah Jahan as a memorial to his beloved queen Mumtaz Mahal, the monument is made of brilliant white marble and is a fine example of symmetry, balance of design and traditional inlay work. As you tour the famed landmark you will have an opportunity to enjoy its changing hues as it is bathed in the warm glow of sunset.



Overnight Hotel in Agra

27 Sept 2019 (Friday) Agra / Jaipur by Surface (240 Km / 5 hrs)

08.00.am: After morning breakfast, depart by surface for Jaipur and check-in at your hotel.

Jaipur City Sightseeing

Tour of the capital city of Rajasthan. Here you will visit the **Hawa Mahal**, Jaipur's central landmark, which boasts of an extraordinary

façade comprised of many airy sandstone windows that were used by the court ladies to watch royal processions without being seen



by outsiders. Next you will explore **City Palace**, which is characterized by balconies, tiny windows, cupolas, courtyards and arched entryways. The Palace now houses an excellent collection of Rajasthani Costumes, miniatures and weaponry. Adjacent to the City Palace lies **Jantar Mantar**, the largest and best preserved of the five observatories built by Jaipur's founder, Jai Singh. At first the observatory appears to be merely a scattering of abstract sculptures, but it is in fact a collection of huge masonry instruments used by medieval scholars to study and measure the positions of the stars, sun and planets. **(B, L & D)**

Overnight Hotel in Jaipur

28 Sept 2019 (Saturday) Amber Fort Jeep Excursion / Delhi – Surface (254 kms / 5 hrs)

Morning at **0800 am**: Checkout with Baggage & then Enjoy the jeep ride ascending from the foothills of Amber to the ramparts of the ancient **Amber Fort**. The fort was once the capital of the Mina tribes, who are believed to be the original inhabitants of the area. Tales of the fort recall the glory and wealth of its association with the Mughals. Once inside, you will explore the Sheesh Mahal, or "Palace of Mirrors," which is inlaid with millions of tiny, glistening mirrors. You will also see the hall of Public Audience and the beautiful manicured gardens. Later you will be driven to Delhi, to be dropped off at Delhi airport. **(B & L)**
