26 Sept 2019 (Thursday) Delhi to Cochin

3.00 AM: Today in the morning after breakfast & check out you will be pickup from Delhi hotel & transferred to Delhi Airport to catch Flight for Cochin.

Depart Delhi by Air India AI-933 ETD 0510 Hrs (or similar)
Arrive Cochin “Economy Class” ETA 0800 hrs
(Check-in baggage allowance 25 kg & Hand baggage allowance 7 kg)

Arrive Kochi airport and met & assist by our representative and transfer to the hotel for check-in.

Kochi (also known as Cochin) is a city in southwest India's coastal Kerala state. It has been a port since 1341, when a flood carved out its harbor and opened it to Arab, Chinese and European merchants. Sites reflecting those influences include Fort Kochi, a settlement with tiled colonial bungalows and diverse houses of worship. Cantilevered Chinese fishing nets, typical of Kochi, have been in use for centuries. Later proceed for a half day guided tour in Cochin visiting Jewish Synagogue, Dutch Palace, ST. Francis Church, Santa Cruz Cathedral, Maritime Museum and Chinese Fishing Nets. Evening witness Kathakali Dance Show Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

27 Sept 2019 (Friday): Cochin - Thekkady

8.00 AM: After breakfast & check out you will be driven to Thekkady (160 Kms / 4.30 Hours drive) to Visit The Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary.

The Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary is spread across 777 km² (300 sq mi), of which 360 square kms (140 sq mi) is thick evergreen forest. The wildlife sanctuary was declared a tiger reserve in 1978. The splendid artificial lake formed by the Mullaperiyar Dam across the Periyar River adds to the charm of the park. The greatest attractions of Periyar are the herds of wild elephants, deer and bison that come down to drink in the lake. The sanctuary can be accessed through a trekking, boating or jeep safari.

Later we visit SPICE PLANTATION.



Enter Kumily and the intoxicating aroma of cloves, nutmeg, pepper, cinnamon or cardamom takes over. The industrial town is the gateway to Thekkady and hosts some of the finest spice plantations in the country.

Evening watch KADATHANADAN KALARI



Kalaripayattu-the oldest of martial arts-is a gift to the modern world and known as the mother of all martial arts. Kalaripayattu originated in ancient south India. Kung-fu, popularized by the monks of the shaoline temple traces its ancestry to Bodhi Dharma-an Indian Buddhist monk and Kalaripayattu master. Dinner and Overnight at the hotel

28 Sept 2019 (Saturday): Thekkady – Alleppey

6 Am: Early in the morning before breakfast we leave for wildlife sanctuary on lake Periyar by boat cruise. One can see herds of elephants grazing near the edges of the shoreline. Deer, sambar, gaur and wild boars can be seen flocking around the place at regular intervals. A majority of the wildlife activity in the area can be viewed ... Darters, egrets and kingfishers can be seen flocking around the withered trees that rise out of the lake. It is a surreal experience that is highly recommended. After tour return back to Hotel.

10 Am: After breakfast & check out, we drive to Alleppey (4 hrs) to board Houseboat for overnight stay.

Alappuzha (or Alleppey) is a city on the Laccadive Sea in the southern Indian state of Kerala. It's best known for houseboat cruises along the rustic Kerala backwaters, a network of tranquil canals and lagoons. Alappuzha Beach is the site of the 19th-century Alappuzha Lighthouse. The city's Mullaikkal Temple features a traditional design. Punnamada Lake's snake boat races are a well-known annual event.
