

**GANDHI CIRCUIT FAM TOUR ITINERARY**  
**05 Days - 04 Nights**  
**Surat 01 - Kevadia 01 - Ahmedabad 01 - Porbandar 01**



*Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi was an Indian lawyer, anti-colonial nationalist, and political ethicist, who employed nonviolent resistance to lead the successful campaign for India's independence from British Rule, and in turn inspire movements for civil rights and freedom across the world.*

*Gujarat, India's westernmost state, has varied terrain and numerous sacred sites. In its urban center of Ahmedabad is the Calico Museum of Textiles, displaying antique and modern Indian fabrics. Spiritual leader Mahatma Gandhi's base from 1917-1930 was Sabarmati Ashram, where his living quarters remain on view. The Jama Masjid (Friday Mosque), built in the 15th century, has a huge courtyard and a columned design.*

**26 Sept 2019 (Thursday) Delhi - Surat (Flight)**

**4 am** Today early morning check out & you will be picked up from the hotel in Delhi & transferred to Delhi airport to catch flight for Surat.

Depart Delhi by Indigo Air 6E-2066                      ETD 0635 hrs (or Similar)  
Arrive Surat "Economy Class"                      ETA 0825 hrs  
(Check-in Baggage allowance is 15-KG & Hand Baggage allowance is 7-KG)

Upon arrival in Surat you will be met & transferred to your hotel for check-in.

Afternoon tour of Surat visiting **European Cemeteries, Surat Castle, Sardar Patel Museum & Local Markets.**



*Surat is a large city beside the Tapi River in the west Indian state of Gujarat. Once known for silk weaving, Surat remains a commercial center for textiles, and the New Textile Market area is lined with fabric shops. Overlooking the river, Surat Castle was built in the 1500s to defend the city against Portuguese colonists. Nearby, the Dutch, Armenian and English cemeteries contain elaborate colonial-era tombs.*

### **Overnight at Hotel in Surat**

#### **27 Sept 2019 (Friday) Surat – Dandi – Surat - Kevadia**

**8 am** After breakfast / check out you will be picked up from the hotel & driven to Dandi (32 Kms). Visit National **Salt Satyagraha Memorial** at Dandi (*Tuesday closed*). Afterward return to Surat for Lunch.

After lunch proceed to **Kevadia** (154 Kms). Upon arrival check in the hotel.

Later we will visit **Statue of Unity** (*Monday closed*). “It is Located close to the holy river of Narmada, **Statue of Unity** is an iconic representation of unity along with being the tallest statue in the world. Dedicated to the iron man of India and the man who is to be credited with the unification India, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, a visit to this statue will evoke a sense of deep patriotism and fascination within you.”

### **Overnight & Dinner at hotel in Kevadia.**

*Kevadiya is a census town in Narmada district in the Indian state of Gujarat. This town is within the vicinity of Statue of Unity and ‘Valley of Flowers’ and a Tent City with 250 tents have been developed in Kevadiya. Kevadiya Railway Station Will be first green building station after completion*



## **28 Sept 2019 (Saturday) Kevadia- Ahmedabad**

**8 am** After breakfast / check out we visit **Viewing Deck** at Statue of Unity and after that proceed to **Ahmedabad** (193 Kms). Upon arrival at Ahmedabad check in at hotel.

Enjoy Lunch at Hotel.

After lunch Visit of **Sabarmati (Gandhi Ashram and Kochrab Ashram)**. "Sabarmati Ashram is located in the Sabarmati suburb of Ahmedabad, Gujarat, adjoining the Ashram Road, on the banks of the River Sabarmati, 4.0 miles from the town hall".

### **Overnight & Dinner at hotel in Ahmedabad.**

*Ahmedabad, in western India, is the largest city in the state of Gujarat. The Sabarmati River runs through its center. On the western bank is the Gandhi Ashram at Sabarmati, which displays the spiritual leader's living quarters and artifacts. Across the river, the Calico Museum of Textiles, once a cloth merchant's mansion, has a significant collection of antique and modern fabrics.*

## **29 Sept 2019 (Sunday) Ahmedabad - Porbandar**

**8 am** After breakfast / check out we depart for **Porbandar** (394 kms) the birth place of **Mahatma Gandhi**. Enroute visit the **Kaba Gandhi No Delo** and **Gandhi Museum** in **Rajkot**.

### **Kaba Gandhi No Delo**

*Kaba Gandhi No Delo, Rajkot was Indian leader Mahatma Gandhi's primary family home in India until 1915, including during those years when he stayed in London and in South Africa. Later on return from South Africa in 1915, he established Kocharab Ashram in Ahmedabad.*



### **Gandhi Museum**

*Mahatma Gandhi Museum, Rajkot was previously known as Mohandas Gandhi Vidhyalaya, Alfred High School and Kathiawar High School established on 17th October 1853 with 36 students. Gandhi Ji completed his graduation from Alfred High School (Kathiawar High School) in the year 1887. Out of 38 students who had passed the high school entrance examination, Gandhiji was one of only two students in his year of matriculate.*

Enjoy Lunch at Rajkot.

After Lunch Proceed to **Porbandar**. Upon arrival at **Porbandar** check in at your hotel.

### Overnight & Dinner at hotel in Porbandar

*Porbandar is a city in the Indian state of Gujarat, perhaps best known for being the birthplace of Mahatma Gandhi and Sudama. It is the administrative center of the Porbandar District and it was the former capital of the Porbandar princely state.*

### **30 Sept 2019 (Monday) Porbandar - Rajkot - Delhi (Flight)**

**7 am** Today after early breakfast / check out you will be picked up from your hotel & taken for a visit to **Kirti Mandir** the memorial house kept in memory of Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi and Kasturba Gandhi located in city of Porbandar, Gujarat, India.



Thereafter you will be driven from Porbandar to Rajkot airport (180 Kms) to catch afternoon flight for Delhi (Enroute stop for quick lunch).

Arrive Delhi "Economy Class"                      ETA 1645 hrs  
(Check-in Baggage allowance is 25 -KG & Hand Baggage allowance is 7-KG)
